

Data Collection Policy

What data we collect?

To make sure the competition is safe and successful we are required to collect, retain and process some of your personal data. Some data also needs to be collected to comply with local laws and the requirements of the World Air Sport Federation (FAI).

Data collected include:

- Full name and surname
- Date of birth
- Nationality
- Phone number
- Email address
- Passport number and validity
- Pilot license copy
- Medical license copy
- FAI sporting license copy
- Medical insurance copy
- Number of hours flown on gliders
- Number of take offs
- Number of cross country kilometres
- FAI badges acquired
- Home aero club
- Location data (as supplied in IGC files during competition and through OGN network)
- Bank account details*

We need to have all the above-mentioned data, except for bank account details, from every competitor to allow him to participate in the competition.

** Bank account details will be collected only if the competitor makes financial transaction to the official bank account of the competition or requests to be paid on his account.*

How we use the data?

All the collected data will be securely stored and protected on our computers and this data will only be shared and processed as outlined in this document.

Most data we collect will never be shared with anybody and are required to ensure safety and compliance with local laws, air rules etc only.

This type of data includes number and validity of your passport, date of birth, and copy of your pilot license, medical license, FAI sporting license and medical insurance. This data is collected only so we can make sure these all documents are valid and to be able to provide information to security enforcement and emergency agencies in case an accident would happen.

We must collect and analyse data regarding your location to be able score each flight. This data will only include the data supplied by competitors in the form of IGC files after

each training and competition flight. This data will be processed by SeeYou application and made public on the soaringspot.com website to comply FAI Sporting Code rules. Your data location will also be collected from FLARM devices through the OGN network and displayed on the tracking system websites (more info on wiki.glidernet.org).

Bank account details will only be stored and used to prepare invoices necessary for the Aeroclub Prievidza s.r.o. and parental company Aeroklub Prievidza o.z.

Data regarding full name and surname, nationality, home aeroclub, number of hours flown gliders hours, number of take offs, number of cross-country kilometres and FAI badges acquired will be made publicly on the competition website.

This data may also be used on the promotional materials, including printed material, websites, social media, and audio-visual recording. This data may also be given to media, sponsors and other companies affiliated with the organisation of the 20th FAI European Gliding Championship.

After the end of the competition your full name and surname, nationality, home aero club, date of birth, FAI license number and location data acquired during the competition will be given to FAI in order to comply with the rules of FAI Sporting Code.

Full name and surname, nationality, home aero club, number of flown gliders hours, number of take-offs, number of cross-country kilometres, FAI badges acquired and location data from competition flights will be retained indefinitely on the competition website and soaringspot.com.

All other data will be retained for the period necessary but no more than 2 years.

Recording and use of audio-visual materials

Please be aware that throughout the competition photographers and cameramen will be present on the airfield and surrounding areas. They will be capturing the competition and you may be recorded as well.

This audio-visual material will then be published on the competition website and social media accounts. These materials may also be used in promotional materials and in the media including newspapers, magazines, TV channels etc.

The audio-visual materials may also be accompanied by information about you which were made public on the competition website and to the media (please refer to the previous section).

These recordings will be retained indefinitely and may be used by Aeroklub Prievidza o.z. and Slovak National Aeroclub M.R.Stefanik in future promotional campaigns.
